

# Young Guns to play in Hays

The Goodland fifth-grade Young Guns will be in Hays on Sunday morning to face Great Bend in the third-place game of the Western Kansas Football League championships.

The Young Guns (4-4) face Great Bend (5-2) in the third place game at 8:30 a.m. Mountain Time at Lewis Field on the campus of Fort Hays State University.

Saturday, the Young Guns won their first-round game 18-12 over previously unbeaten Smoky Valley.

The win raised the team's record to 4-3 and dropped Smoky Valley to 5-1.

Then Young Guns were shut out 13-0 by unbeaten Phillipsburg (8-0) in the second round on Sunday at Lewis Field.

Great Bend defeated the Hays Gamblers on Saturday 26-0, but lost to the Hays Chiefs 39-7 on Sunday.

The championship game at 2 p.m. Mountain Time at Lewis Field will feature the Chiefs and Phillipsburg. Both teams are undefeated (8-0).
