percent., the same margin he got in the district with 5,109 votes. Libertarian Dannis Robison got 71 votes in Sherman County for 4 percent and Reform candidate Art R. Richmond had 125 votes for 7 percent.

Republican Congressman Jerry Moran easily won re-election, getting 83 percent (1,563) in Sherman County and 79 percent (153,298) across the 69 counties of the 1st District. Democrat John Doll had 16 percent (305) in Sherman County and 20 percent (33,320) in the dis-

trict. Reform candidate Sylvester Cain had 20 votes in Sherman County and 2,792 across the district for 1 percent.

Sherman County joined in returning Republican Secretary of State Ron Thornburg with 77 percent (1,427) and 64 percent (516,505) statewide. Democrat David Haley had 20 percent (365) in Sherman County and 32 percent (257,472) statewide.

Republican Lynn Jenkins won re-election as state treasurer, getting 74 percent (1,356) in Sherman County and 64 percent (512,961) statewide. Democrat Larry Wilson had 26 per-

cent (487) in Sherman County and 36 percent (283,247) statewide.

Commissioner of Insurance Sandy Praeger, a Republican, won another term, getting 73 percent (1,349) in Sherman County and 63 percent (504,728) statewide. Democrat Bonnie Sharp had 22 percent (412) in Sherman County and 33 percent (259,912) statewide.

In the state, the Democrats picked up the 2nd Congressional District seat, with Democrat Nancy Boyda (106, 513) upsetting incumbent Republican Jim Ryun (98,277).

## Blood drive to be Wednesday, Thursday

The American Red Cross reports a dangerous drop in blood donations across the Midwest this fall, but you can help by donating when the agency’s blood drive comes to Goodland next week.

The drive will be in Goodland from noon to 6 p.m. Wednesday and from 8 a.m. to 2:30 p.m. Thursday at the Northwest Kansas Technical College Student Union. Call 1-800-GIVE LIFE to schedule an appointment. Walk-in donors welcome.

For the past few months, the Central Plains Region has struggled to keep up with demand, officials say. Blood collections have lagged an average of 35 pints per day.

“That’s about 250 pints per week,” said Terri Dunaway, Red Cross donor recruitment director, “with a total decrease of nearly 2,000 pints since summer.”

The region needs to collect nearly 500 units of blood each weekday, Dunaway said, to meet

the needs of hospital patients.

Donors must be in general good health, weigh 110 pounds or more, and be at least 17, or 16 in Kansas with parental consent.

“Many people want to wait until someone they know has had an accident,” said Dunaway. “What they need to know is that it takes three days for blood to be tested and distributed before it can be transfused. It needs to be on the hospital shelf and ready when it is needed.”
