

Goodland grad earns honor

Kansas State University senior Donald Raymer earned a place on the K-State 2006 Football Academic All-Big 12 Team.

The academic all-big 12 football teams comprises 146 student athletes, 92 on the first team and 54 on the second. The student must maintain a 3.0 or higher grade average, either cumulatively or for the two previous semesters, and played in 60 percent of a team's games.

Raymer, son of Steve and Debra Raymer of Goodland, is majoring in secondary education.

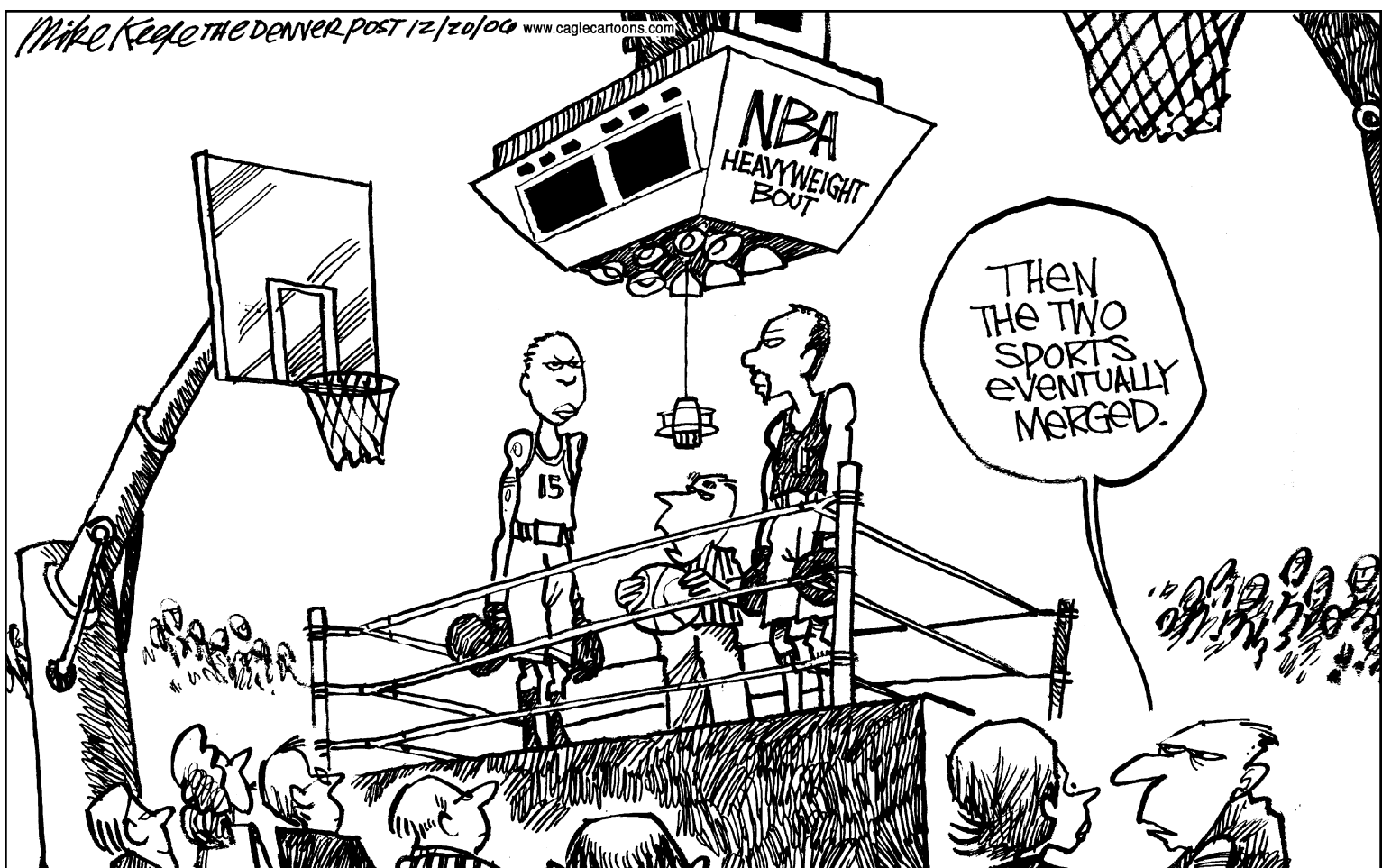
He played in 12 games for the Wildcats, gaining a total of eight yards with an average of 2.7 yards per carry. His longest run was

seven yards.

K-State will be playing against the 16th-ranked Scarlet Knights of Rutgers in the first Texas Bowl at 6 p.m. on Thursday, Dec. 28, at Reliant Stadium in Houston. The NFL network, S & T channel 35 and Eagle channel 45, will carry the game.

Rutger finished the season tied for second in the Big East Conference with a 10-2 record. Their coach, Greg Schiano, was the Home Depot Coach of the Year.

Rookie coach Ron Prince and the Wildcats ended the season with a 7-5 record. K-State has been in 11 consecutive bowl games.
