The eighth graders had a tougher time, falling behind Goodland 4-2 at in the first quarter. Oberlin was ahead at the half 8-6 but Goodland pulled ahead to win 21-15.

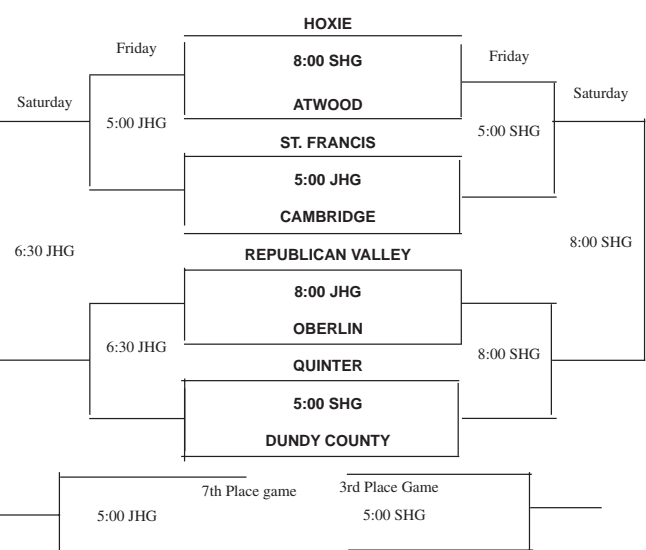
Scoring for the eighth grade were Jamie Elwood, 6; Trina Shields, 5; and Molly Coleman and Justine Miller, 2 each.

In the eighth grade, fifth quarter Oberlin beat Goodland 5-0.

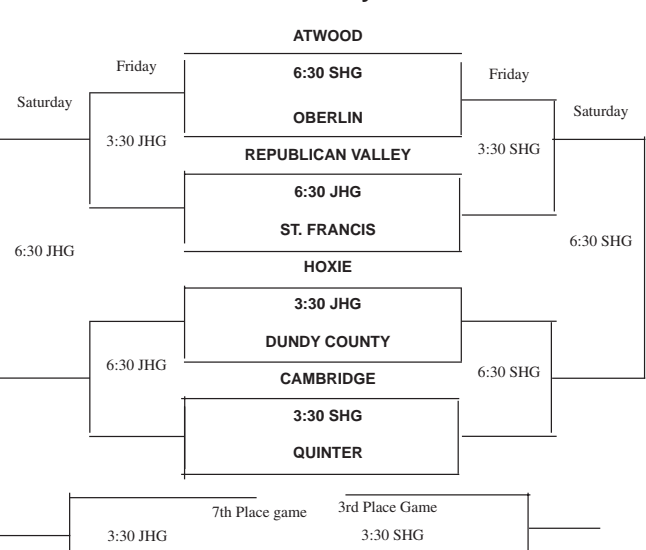
The girls will be at Atwood on Thursday for a 4:30 p.m. start.

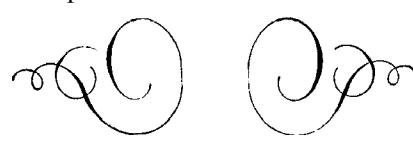
The girls will be in Phillipsburg this week for the Cheyenne Conference Tournament on Tuesday, Friday and Saturday.

Landscape program offered

Alice Hemsath will present the program, Landscape Ideas and Plant Selection, from 10 a.m. to 1 p.m. on Thursday, Jan. 25, at Walsh/Brady Hall, room 130, at McCook Community College.

She will teach how to arrange a landscape planting using plant material adapted to low water and maintenance. Native plants should be used that are adapted to low water require-

ments and still have an attractive landscape and flower bed. Grasses used in the proper location can add to the landscape. Trees, shrubs and vegetables as part of the variations will be explored.



Notice of Personal Property Assessment

Personal property renditions must be filed between January 1 and March 15. Renditions filed after March 15 will have a penalty for late filing. Taxable personal property includes: business and shop equipment, computers and printers, boats, motor and trailers, aircraft, mobile homes, camping and travel trailers, flatbed and car trailers, mopeds, ATV's, golf cars, trucks, non-tagged and non-highway vehicles and improvements on leased land.

The Decatur County Appraiser's Office needs to be notified of the sale of any personal property during 2000. All taxpayers must file before the March 15 deadline.

All new businesses in Decatur County are required to contact the Decatur County Appraiser's Office to report business equipment for tax purposes.

If you have no personal property to report, please call us to verify that you are in the county for census purposes.

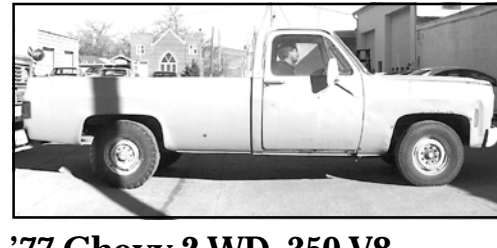

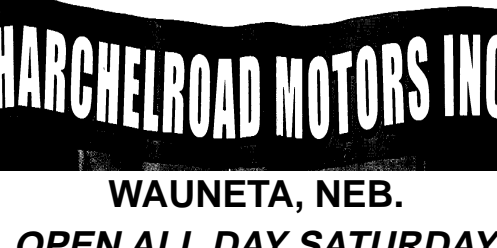
