PUBLICATION OF INTENT TO FILE AN APPLICATION FOR PERMISSION TO VOTE AND ISSUE SCHOOL BONDS IN EXCESS OF THE DISTRICT GENERAL BOND DEBT LIMITATION

To the Electors of Unified School District No. 294, Decatur County, Kansas (Oberlin):  
You are hereby notified that the Board of Education (the "Board"), of Unified School District No. 294, Decatur County, Kansas (Oberlin) (the "District"), will make and file its application with the permission to vote general obligation bonds (the "Bonds") in excess of the District's general bond debt limitation for the purpose of providing funds to pay a portion of the estimated \$5,871,130 costs to: (i) construct, furnish and equip additions to the existing Oberlin Elementary School to create a new media center (library), restrooms, additional classrooms, storage and corridors; (ii) remodel and make improvements to, including heating, ventilation, air-conditioning and electrical upgrades to the existing Oberlin Elementary School for educational purposes and for compliance with the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA); (iii) remodel and make improvements, including heating, ventilation, air-conditioning and electrical upgrades to the existing Decatur Community junior/senior High School; and (iv) make all other necessary improvements appurtenant thereto (the "Project"). A portion of the costs of the Project will be payable from proceeds of the Bonds in an amount not to exceed \$5,613,000; the balance of the costs shall be paid from available capital outlay funds of the District and interest earnings on bond proceeds.

The application will be filed pursuant to a resolution adopted by the Board on February 12, 2001, under the authority of K.S.A. 75-2135 et seq., as amended.

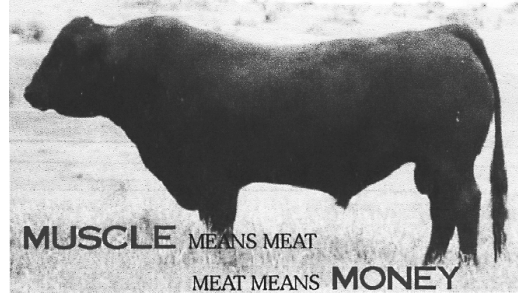
