## Oberlin girls take first place; boys come in third at Quinter

The Decatur Community High girls took first place and the boys third at their first track meet of the season on Friday.

The teams traveled to Quinter for a triangular meet against the Bulldogs and the Atwood Buffaloes.

Taking first place for the girls were Dana Sattler, pole vault, 7-feet, 3-inches; Dani Dorshorst, 100-meter high hurdles, 18.6 seconds, and 300-meter hurdles, 57.49; Leah Marietta,

100-meter dash, 14.03; and Lindsay Fortin, Rena Unger, Marietta and Abby Ream in the 4X100-meter relay, 56.84.

Coming in second were Ream, javelin, 104-4; Unger, long jump, 14-1 1/4-inches; Kerrie Olson, 100-meter high hurdles, 19 minutes; Keely Witt, 1,600-meter run, 8:33.31, and 800 meters, 2:51.08; Fortin, 200 meters, 29.76; Kelsey Dorshorst, 3,200 meters, 14:05.58; Unger, Fortin, Korney Stapp and Marietta, 4X400 relay, 4:59.13;

and K. Dorshorst, D. Dorshorst, Witt and Stapp, 4X800-meter relay, 11:44.87.

Placing third were Stapp, 800 meters, 2:56.86; Kimia Bundgard, 3,200 meters, 14:52.26; and K. Dorshorst, discus, 70-10, and high jump, 4-6.

Taking fourth was Ream, pole vault, 6-6.

Quinter's girls came in second and Atwood third.

Taking first for Oberlin's boys team were Rusty Grafel, long jump, 18-4 1/2, and 800 meters, 2:18.1, and Kenyon Badsky, Chris Barth, Jeremy Karnopp and Grafel, 4X100 relay, 48.59.

Placing second were Grafel, Ryan Ruf, Dustin Ketterl and Matt Coleman, 4X800-meter relay, 9:34.9.

Running third was Badsky, 100 meters, 12.64, and 200 meters, 25.71.

Taking fourth were Ruf, javelin, 145; and Chance Harman, pole vault, 9-6.

Coming in fifth was Coleman, pole vault, 9-6.

The Quinter boys won the meet and Atwood came in second.

The students were scheduled to go to Hoxie Tuesday and will be in Atwood next Tuesday for a 3 p.m. invitational meet.

The junior high students start their track and field season at 10 a.m. Thursday in Oakley.
