missioner district shall not affect the terms of incumbent board members for the duration of the member's term. Members shall serve without compensation and shall hold office until their successor is appointed and qualified. If a missioner district, disqualification shall occur and a vacancy shall be declared if such change in residency results in more than four (4) members in any particular commissioner district. Section 3. That the Decatur County Fair Advisory Board shall advise and counsel the

Board of County Commissioners concerning the operation and management of fairgrounds property, and shall have the authority to plan and manage the annual county free fair. Insofar as is consistent with the provisions of this Charter Resolution, said board shall exercise the duties and powers given the board of directors of fair associations under K.S.A. 2-128. The Decatur County Fair Advisory Board
