## Four Red Devils named all-league

Two Oberlin boy and two girl basketball players have been picked for the annual all-league team.

Senior Ryan Ruf and junior Egan Grafel were among 10 boys chosen for the all-league team by the coaches of the Northwest Kansas League, said Oberlin Coach Dick Ahlberg.

Senior Kortney Stapp was chosen for the all-league team for the girls and junior Abby Ream was chosen as an honorable mention, said Oberlin Coach Paul Nepodal.

Ruf had 22.8 points, 7.6 rebounds, 3.9 assists and 3 steals average per game while Grafel had 14.9 points, 10 rebounds, 4 blocked

shots and 2.8 assists average per game.

This is Ruf's third year as an all-league player. Coach Ahlberg said this was the first time in more than 20 years of coaching he has had a player make all-league three times.

Ruf will be playing in the Heart of America All-Star game at Kansas Wesleyan University in Salina at 7 p.m. Saturday.

For the girls, Stapp, a 5-foot, 7-inch player, has averaged 13 points and seven rebounds per game. Ream is 5-foot, 4-inch junior.
