The Decatur Community High girls team came in second and the boys fourth in the busy St. Francis Invitational last Tuesday.

Hoxie led the girls teams with 82 points, followed by Oberlin with 76, and Atwood, 71.

Oakley won the boys section with 98 points, followed by St. Francis, 92, Tri-Plains, 69, and Oberlin 59.

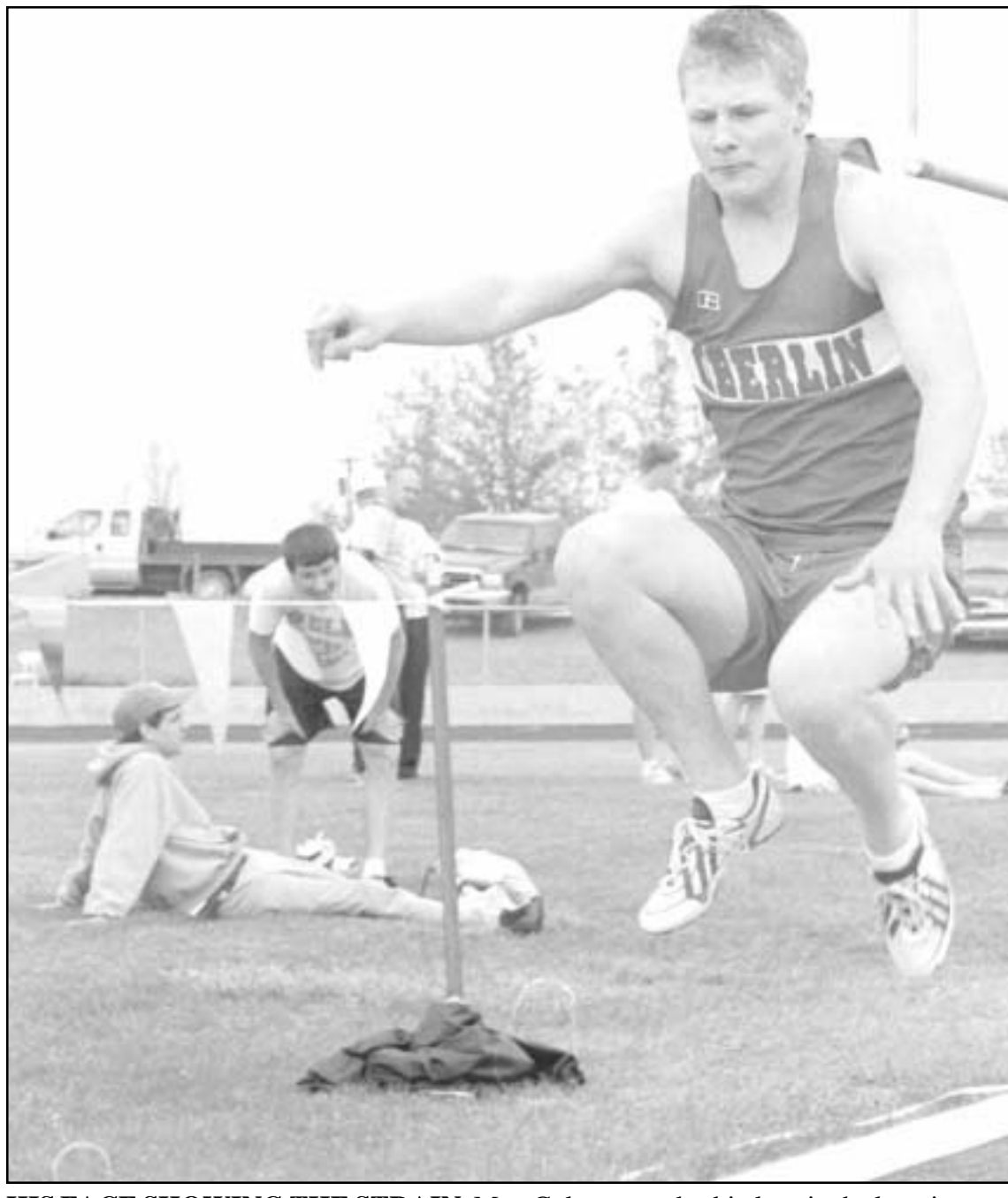
Abby Ream was the only Oberlin individual to take a first place. She came in first in the pole vault and the javelin. The boys 4X800-meter relay team also took first place.
