

Herndon players make all conference

Four Herndon basketball players won all-conference honors in the Cheyenne Conference.

Lance Basgall, who averaged 13.4 points, 5.8 assists, 4.5 rebounds and 3.8 steals for the Beavers, was a unanimous first-team selection on the list announced Thursday.

Curtis Brown, who averaged 12.8 points and 8.1 rebounds per game and had a 67.5 field goal percentage made the second team.

Brett Chambers, who averaged 8.4 points and 5.2 rebounds per game and had a 39.5 percent three-point field goal percentage, also made the second team.

Abe Marintzer, who had 14.9 points, 5.9 rebounds, 3.2 steals and 2.2 assists per game, received honorable mention.

The Beavers boys ended their season last Saturday in the substate championship, losing to Weskan 81-61.

The Beavers posted a 23-2 record, with both losses to the Weskan Coyotes, in their last season.

The game marked the end of Beaver sports. Herndon High will close its doors at the end of this school year, and the school will have kindergarten through sixth grade only.

"The score might have not been what the Beavers and the fans of Herndon were looking for," Coach Ryan Becker said, "but we ended on our own terms, fighting and scratching to the final horn."

Scoring were Basgall, 19; Marintzer, 11; Daron Chambers, 10; B. Chambers, 7; Jeff Riener, 6; and

Dan Riener, Ben Grafel, Brown and Brett Sagel, 2 each.

"The Beavers can look back on their most successful year in athletics ever," Coach Becker said.

The football team went 9-2 and made it to the Nebraska-Kansas six-man championship game, while the basketball team only lost two games all season.

"The boys finished the year 32-4 for both sports and played a year to remember," the coach said. "Myself, the other coaches, players and student body of Herndon High School would like to personally thank the parents, fans and supporters of Herndon athletics for this season and all years prior. Your dedication to athletics was crucial to the success of this last and final season."
