## Sewer rate ordinance

ORDINANCE #788

An ordinance establishing sewer rates for the City of Oberlin, amending City Code Section 14-310.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF OBERLIN, KANSAS

Section 1: The minimum sewer charge per month shall be \$14.50 per 300 cubic feet of water or portion thereof based upon average water usage during the annual review period. For usage beyond the minimum charge, each contributor shall pay a user charge rate for operation and maintenance including replacement of \$2.23 per 100 cubic feet or portion thereof based upon average water usage during the annual review period.

Section 2: All ordinances or city code sections in conflict herewith are hereby repealed including but not limited to City Code section 14-310.

Section 3: This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its publication in the official city newspaper.
