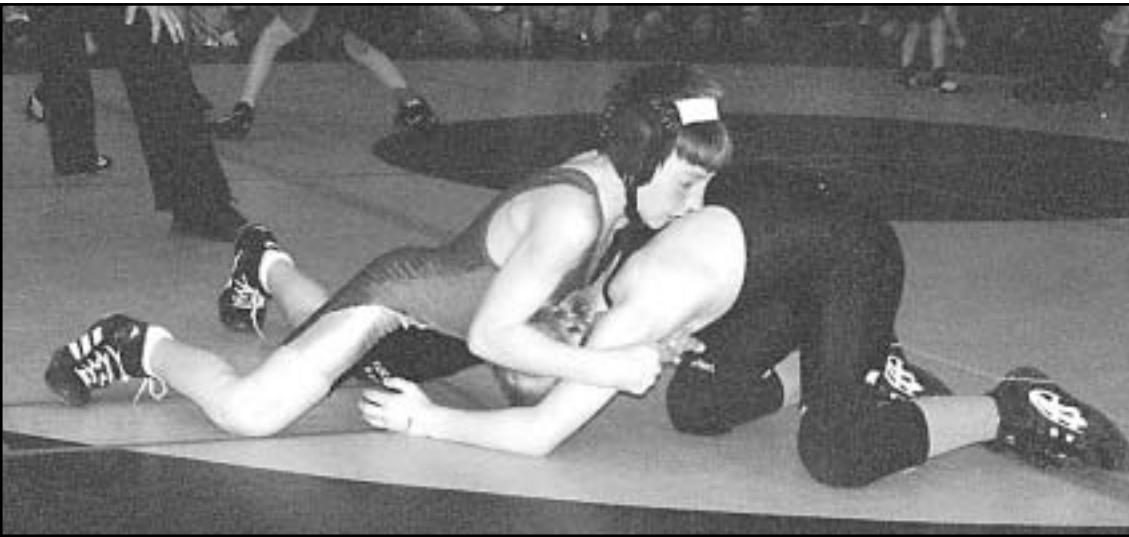

Girls place in Nebraska gymnastics

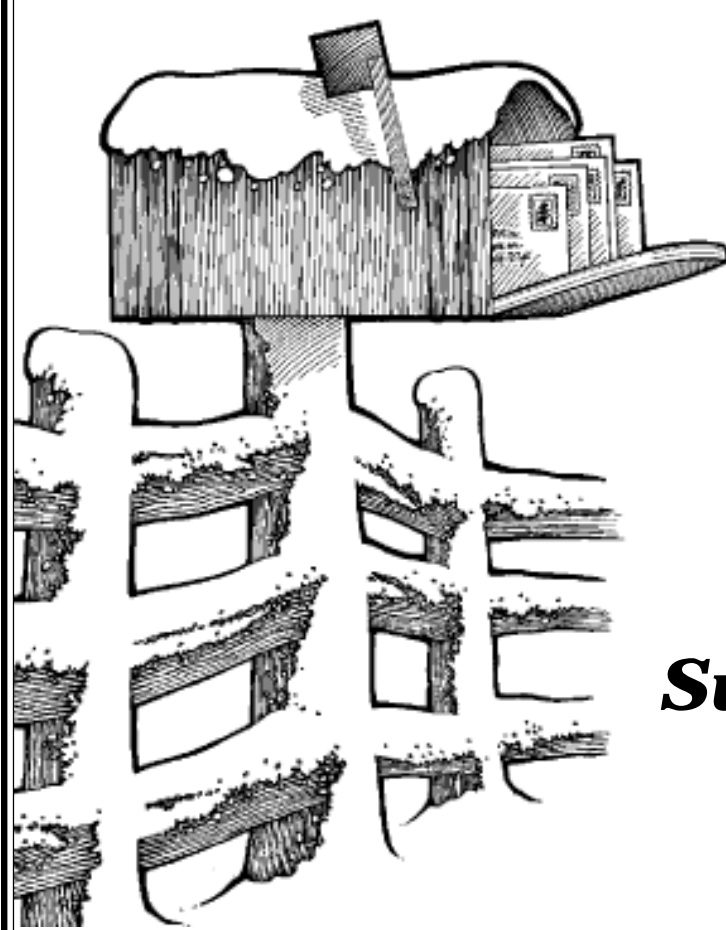
Three Oberlin girls attended the Twister Gymnastic exhibition in Grand Island, Neb., on March 6 and 7.
