

Girls take first, boys second in first meet

The Decatur Community High girls finished first with 204 points and the boys second with 66, in their first track meet of the season on Friday in Oberlin.

The girls notched a dozen first places, 11 seconds and 10 thirds.

The boys came up with seven firsts, three seconds and three thirds.

Quinter finished first in the boys events with 127 points and second in the girls with 56 and Atwood came in third in both, as the Buffalo boys had 56 points and the girls 43.
