

# Oberlin wrestlers win matches

Oberlin seniors Matt Coleman, 145 pounds; Chance Harman, 160 pounds, and Brett Keck, 171 pounds, were winners in the 18th annual Senior Classic Wrestling Dual in front of 1,200 fans March 26 at the Kansas ExpoCentre in Topeka.

Thirty-eight of the top senior wrestlers in the state were in the dual. Wrestlers were selected to either the Blue Team, coached by Manhattan's Lee Woodford and (Kansas City) Turner High's Peter Sierant, or the Red Team, coached by Scott City's Jon Lippelmann. The Red Team, which included all

three of Oberlin's wrestlers, won 32-30.

Coleman won 9-1 over Kyle Heincker, Derby.

Chance Harman won 4-2 over Derek Lang, Baldwin.

Brett Keck won 4-3 over Mike Steinmetz, Kansas City Turner.
