Two Oberlin golfers win berths at state tournament

Two Decatur Community High golfers will be swinging at the Class 2A-1A state meet in Salina on Monday.

Matt Mondero, who has taken a medal in every tournament this year and was named a Northwest Kansas League all-league player for the fourth year in a row, took fourth place in the Class 2A-1A Regional tournament Monday in Hoxie.

Mondero shot a 43 and a 36 for 80. Oberlin's Jonathon Richards took eighth place in the meet, shooting a 38 and a 43 for an 81 to win his second trip to state.

This will be Mondero's four and last trip to the state meet, as he will

Salina Municipal Golf Course on Monday.
