AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR A PUBLIC FIREWORKS DISPLAY AT THE DECATUR COUNTY FAIR

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF OBERLIN, KANSAS:
