The Closing of Voter Registration Books for Decatur County will adhere to the following schedule:
Decatur County Voter Registration Books will close Monday, the 7th of February, 2005 at 9 PM — through the Primary City/School Election — if needed — see above —, Tuesday the 22nd day of February, 2005.

NOTE: The Courthouse will be closed for Presidents' Day on Monday, the 21st of February — however — the Clerk's Office will be in the Office working on Election.

Voter Registration Books will reopen on Wednesday, the 23rd day of February, 2005, if a Primary Election was held.

If there is no City/School Primary Election held, registration books will remain open through the month of February and then subject to the following dates:
Registration Books will be closed for the General Election from Monday the 21st of March, 2005 at 9 PM, through the City/School General Election Day, the 5th of April, 2005.
Voter Registration Books will then reopen on Wednesday, the 6th day of April, 2005.

Anyone wishing to register to vote may do so in the County Clerk's Office during office hours (8 AM to 5 PM) but anyone coming in after the books are closed, their name will be added to the list for the next upcoming election.

Re-registration is not necessary unless you have changed residences since the last election or had a name change by legal court action.

CHARTER ORDINANCE NO. 14

CHARTER ORDINANCE AMENDING CHARTER ORDINANCE NO. 11 regarding the Transient Guest Tax

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF OBERLIN, KANSAS:
Section 1: Section 2 of Charter Ordinance #11 is hereby amended to read as follows: A transient guest tax shall be levied in the City of Oberlin, Kansas at a rate of three percent upon the gross rental receipts derived from or paid by transient guests for lodging or sleeping accommodations, exclusive of charges for incidental services or facilities, in any hotel or motel.
Section 2: **Publication.** This Charter Ordinance shall be published once each week for two consecutive weeks in the official city newspaper.
Section 3: **Effective Date.** This Charter Ordinance shall take effect 61 days after final publication unless a sufficient petition for a referendum is filed, requiring a referendum to be held on the ordinance as provided in Article 12.

Section 5, of the Constitution of the State of Kansas, in which case this Charter Ordinance shall become effective upon approval by a majority of the electors voting thereon.
