Boys outscored Friday by opponents in Goodland

The Red Devil boys basketball team was downed Friday night by the Goodland Cowboys, 72-57.

The Devils kept the points close in the first and final quarters but the Cowboys dominated in the second and third. In the first quarter it was 11-12; second, 13-20; third, 14-21; and in the fourth, both teams got 19 points.

Lance Fortin took the lead in points Friday with 17, followed by Andy Inman with 11. Others who scored were Jason Thomas with 7, Teryn Grafel with 6, Andy Leitner and Jesse Juenemann both got 4,

Andy Anderson with 3, Josh Fortin, 2, and Jace Robinson, 1.

Lance Fortin led the rebounds with 8. Others were Grafel and Inman with 5 each, Anderson with 4, Robinson with 2, and Leitner, Juenemann and Josh Fortin with 1 each.

Those with assists were Thomas and Juenemann with 4 each, Lance Fortin and Anderson with 2, and Leitner, Grafel, Inman and Josh Fortin, 1.

Thomas had 2 steals and Lance Fortin, Juenemann, Inman, Jason Fortin and Anderson, 1.

"This game was not pretty," said Coach Dick Ahlberg. "Our defense was not very good. Goodland shot 58 percent, but we allowed them to get into the paint too easily. We shot only 39 percent, our shot selection and offensive execution was sub par."

He said that Goodland has a solid, physical team.

"We took a lickin'," said Coach Ahlberg, "but we're still tickin'."

The Devils were scheduled to play Grinnell on Tuesday at home and will go to Colby on Friday.

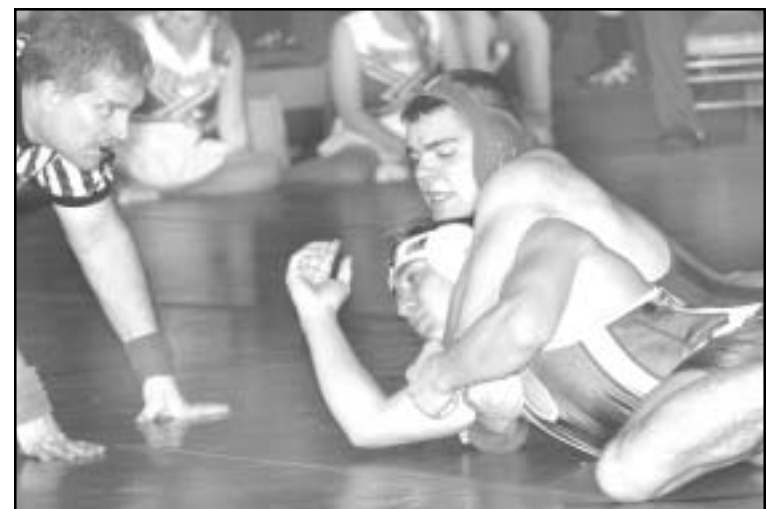
Devils fall to Cowboys at home
