Noxious weed control

(Published in The Oberlin Herald, Wednesday, March 23, 2005)1t GENERAL NOTICE TO CONTROL NOXIOUS WEEDS The Kansas Noxious Weed Law K.S.A. 2-

1314 et seg requires all persons who own or supervise land in Kansas to control and eradicate all weeds declared noxious be legislative action. The weeds declared noxious are: Field Bindweed, Musk Thistle, Serica Lespedeza, Johnson Grass, Canada Thistle, Bur Ragweed, Leafy Spurge, Hoary Cress, Quack Grass, Russian Knapweed, Kudzu, and Pignut. Multiflora Rose is a County option Noxious Weed declared noxious by the Board of County hereby given pursuant to the Kansas Noxious Weed Law to every person who owns or supervises land in Decatur County that noxious weeds growing or found on such land shall be controlled and eradicated. Control is defined as preventing the production of viable seeds and the vegetative spread of the plant.

Failure to observe this notice may result in the County:

1. Serving a legal notice requiring control of the noxious weeds within a minimum of 5 days. Failure to control the noxious weeds within the time period allowed may result in the county expense and placing a lien on the property if the bill is not paid within 30 days or,

2. Filing criminal charges for non compliance. Conviction for non compliance may result in a fine of \$100 per day of non compliance with a maximum fine of \$1500.

The public is also hereby notified that it is a violation of Kansas Noxious Weed Law to barter, sell, or give away infested nursery stock or livestock feed unless the feed is fed on the farm where grown or sold to a commercial processor that will destroy the viability of the noxious weed seed. Custom harvesting machines must be labeled with a label provided by the Kansas Dept. of Agriculture and must be free of all weed seed and litter when entering the State and when leaving a field infested with noxious weeds. Township Board that, to the extent possible ithin the context of the needs of township resi dents, a 2006 Budget for OBERLIN Township will be adopted that does not require property taxes to be levied for township purposes in an amount exceeding an amount levied to finance the 2005 OBERLIN Township Budget, except with regard to revenue produced and attributable to taxation of 1) new improvements to real property; 2) increased personal property valu ation, other than increased valuation of oil and gas leaseholds and mobile homes; and 3) roperty which has changed in use during the past year, or with regard to revenue produced for the purpose of repaying the principal of and interest upon bonded indebtedness, tempoor no-fund warrants: and

WHEREAS, despite the desire of the OBERLIN Township Board to adopt a 2006 Budget while adhering to a maximum level of property taxation described in the foregoing paragraph, the residents of OBERLIN Town ship are to be aware that the 2006

OBERLIN Township Budget will require property taxes to be levied in an amount greater level defined in the preceding paragraph, due to road improvements.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED County that it is our desire to notify the public of the increased property taxes to finance the 2006 OBERLIN Township Budget as defined above and in the 1999 Senate Bill 45.
