

Eighth-graders place third, fourth at League meet

The Oberlin eighth-grade boys took third at the Northwest Kansas League tournament on May 11 in St. Francis, with the 4x400-meter relay team setting a new league record. The Decatur Community High seventh-grade and eighth-grade girls both placed fourth and the seventh-grade boys came in eighth. "I felt our eighth-grade boys and girls really competed well," Coach Keith Grafel said. "We did a nice job of scoring points where we could, and some people really stepped up and gave their best efforts. "I felt our seventh graders did not compete very well at all. We had a few individuals that did well, but overall, we just didn't get the job done. "We hope next year we will be considerably better and compete for a league title.
