

Oberlin golfers finish high at state tourney

Two Decatur Community High golfers went to the state tournament in Emporia last week, and one brought home a medal. Oberlin junior Jonathon Richards came in 14th at the Class 2A-1A state golf tournament at the Emporia Municipal Golf Course last Monday. He shot a 41 and 38 for a 79 to earn his medal. Sophomore Breck Simonsson finished in the top half, 40th out of 106 players. "The guys played pretty well," Coach Dick Ahlberg said. "I am proud of the way they competed. "With these two players and five additional lettermen, we are very

excited about next year. We hope to qualify our team (for state) and be competitive at the state level." The Oberlin team came in third at the regional meet on May 16. However, only the top two teams and top 10 individuals at regionals get to go on. Winning the state golf tournament were Trinity High School of Hutchinson, 319 points; Syracuse, 327; St. Marys, 332; Hoxie, 332; Pittsburg-Colgan, 332; Marmaton Valley of Moran, 334; South Central in Coldwater, 335; WaKeeney, 347; Pretty Prairie, 353; Sacred Heart in Salina, 356; Centralia, 368; and Stanton County, 369.

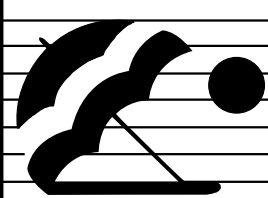

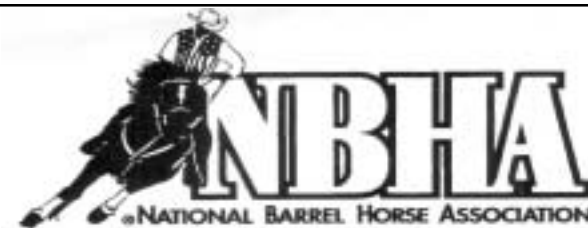
