Oberlin man picks up fourth win on hot night

It was hot both on and off the race track at the Oberlin Speedway last week as fans braved 100-degreeplus weather to watch seven divi-

David Murray Jr. of Oberlin picked up his fourth IMCA Modified win in five races at Oberlin this season. Murray, who also won the second heat race, was chased to the checkers by Marty Clark, Rick Schwab, John Fose and Don Hagan Jr. in a caution-free race. Hometown driver Tyson Garrison won the other heat race.

Stockton's Tyler Hahn finally found his way to victory lane with a win in the IMCA Stock Car feature. Hahn was able to hold off Bryan Lariviere, the feature winner at the Speed Bowl in Red Cloud, Neb., Friday night, to the checkers. Cory Struckhoff finished third, followed by Jason Schoenberger and Jason Rogers. Heat race winners were Josh Hudson and Hahn.

Brian Conness of WaKeeney topped a 10-car field to win the IMCA Hobby Stock feature, his first ever. Conness, who also won the second heat race, won the battle of heat race winners. Heat 1 winner Gene Sneath had to settle for the runner-up spot. Brady Schoen, Rhona Annon and Phil Hinger rounded out

the top five. Kensington's Donald Dodds won his fourth Bomber feature of the year. Dodds led all the way in the caution-free event. Brent Moss was

second and Allen Kurth, third. Wes and Chuck Eagleburger of

Norton also won their fourth feature of the season on the 3/8-mile oval. Jeremy Simmons and Roger Deal, who led all but the final two laps, finished second, followed by heat race winners Jim Carter and Josh Hud-

After a disappointing fourthplace finish in the Classic Modified heat race, Larry Pollmann of Mc-Cook bounced back to win his third feature of the season, leading from green to checkered in a race that went without a caution. A.C. Werner and John Werner finished second and third.

The Mini Trucks made their second appearance of the season and Cindy Murray returned to victory lane with a feature win. Andrew Richards was second and Curtis Richards third.

The regular six classes will return to action at Oberlin Speedway on Sunday evening, Aug. 14, during the Decatur County Fair. Race time will be 6:30 p.m.
