

Oberlin girls swim well in first meet

Several Oberlin swimmers are keeping their skills sharp by joining the McCook YMCA Devil Rays swim team during the winter months.

Eleven Oberlin girls took part in the team's first meet in Grand Island on Oct. 22.

"Over 100 swimmers from Kearney, Grand Island, Hastings and McCook competed in this event," said Coach Tracy Flaska. "For the first meet, I was very pleased with the performances.

"Most of the kids had times faster than last year. Some of the distances are different than summer leagues, and it can be difficult when a swimmer changes ages groups, from the 8 and under to 9 and 10, for instance, and has to double the distance.

"Alexis Hissong, Kaylee May, Madison Monaco and Jamie Soderlund all swam longer distances and did very well.


