Cowboys up on Red Devils 73-36

Friday night, the 4A Goodland Cowboys (11-4) cowboied up on the Decatur Community High Red Devils (3-11) 73-36 in boys basketball action.

From the start Goodland took command of the game, using their up tempo transition game to outscore the Red Devils 22-11 in the first quarter. The Cowboys came out in a full court man to man press, using 10 players to press the Red Devils during the game.

In the second quarter, Goodland continued to put a choke hold on the Red Devils with the man press, suffocating their offense.

At the other end of the floor, the Cowboys made good passes for easy baskets.

Oberlin suffered through another poor shooting night averaging 25 percent from the field to the Cowboys' 70 percent.

The Cowboys outscored Oberlin 21-10 in the second quarter to take a 43-21 lead at intermission due to

defensive errors.

In the third quarter, Goodland's bench depth took over as Cowboy Coach Jon McLean emptied it, playing all 12 players. The Red Devils were outscored 15-10.

"Goodland is a good 4A team," said Coach Dick Ahlberg. "Their execution was good tonight."

Entering the fourth quarter, Oberlin trailed the Cowboys 58-31. The Red Devils continued to be outscored in the fourth quarter 15-5 resulting in the lopsided loss 73-36.

Jase Herl lead Goodland with 18 points followed by Nick Angelos at 16.

Andy Inman was the top scorer for Oberlin with 12 points followed by Nolan May, scoring six points.

The Red Devils travel to Grinnell Tuesday. Games start at 4 p.m.

The Devils are home Friday facing Colby. Games at home start at 6:30 p.m.

"We have a busy week," said Coach Ahlberg. "We will work on our defense intensity."

The Red Devils twisted their bodies in all directions last Saturday during the Northwest Kansas League Tournament in Goodland to finish in second place.

Colby, a larger 4A school, won the tournament by nine and one-half points, 170 to 161.5.

Of the 12 places in the tournament, Oberlin crowned two league champions, Scott Miller in the 160-pound division and Terry Urban in the 171-pound division.

Gage Reichert in the 119-pound division, Jonhathon Richards in the 140-pound division, and Brock Euhus in the 275-pound division finished in second place.

Aaron Helm in the 103-pound division, Breck Simonsson in the 135-pound division, Denton Bailey in the 152-pound division, Bret Marietta in the 189-pound division and Regan Badsy in the 215-pound division finished in third place.
