Lady Red Devils start preseason practice

Volleyballs were flying like popcorn in a popper during last week's preseason practice sessions at Decatur Community High School. The 2006 edition of Coach Patricia Dorshorst's Lady Devils looked like ants working busily in their colony, moving around in every direction, preparing for their first home matches at 4:30 p.m. Friday with Hoxie and Grainfield. Dorshorst led her troops through

basic drills last week, teaching communication and team work. With the gymnasium divided in half, the varsity worked on one side and the junior varsity on the other. Serves and preparatory sets for spikes filled the air in the crowded gym, where about 40 girls worked on developing and refining their individual skills. "We currently have 41 girls out this fall," said Dorshorst. "So far, we do not have any major injuries that

might hamper us. Senior Kim Wessel is currently nursing a shoulder injury, but should return to the lineup very soon." In the small gym, junior high Coach Melissa Dreher worked with the younger girls, demonstrating techniques necessary to prepare them for their upcoming season and the skills to prepare them for high school play. "All the girls are working hard in preparation for our first match," said

Dreher. "We want them ready from the get-go." The junior high girls first games will be at 4:30 p.m. Thursday, Aug. 31, against St. Francis in the "Devils' Pit" (the small gym) in Oberlin. "We are preparing very hard," she said. "Last season we lost our first four matches before we started putting it together. We want to get off to a good start this season. We are excited to have a strong returning team this season."
