RESOLUTION NOTICE FOR 2007 SPECIAL BUDGET LEVY INCREASE Townships and Cemetery

A RESOLUTION EXPRESSING THE PROPERTY TAXATION POLICY OF THE BOARDS OF THE FOLLOWING LISTED TOWNSHIPS WITH RESPECT TO FINANCING THE 2007 ANNUAL BUDGET FOR THE FOLLOWING LISTED TOWNSHIPS OF DECATUR COUNTY, KANSAS.

WHEREAS, budgeting taxing and service level decisions for all township services are the responsibility of the township board; and WHEREAS, the ad valorem property tax is a primary source of revenue for financing township services; and

WHEREAS, it is the policy of the following listed Township Boards to minimize the property taxes used to finance township services at the lowest possible level, while exercising our stewardship responsibility to maintain basic services for our citizens; and

WHEREAS, it is the policy of the following listed Township Boards that, to the extent possible within the context of the needs of township residents, a 2007 Budget for the following listed Townships will be adopted that does not require property taxes to be levied for township purposes in an amount exceeding an amount levied to finance the 2006 following listed Township Budgets, except with regard to revenue produced and attributable to taxation of 1) new improvements to real property; 2) increased personal property valuation, other than increased valuation of oil and gas leaseholds and mobile homes; and 3) property which has changed in use during the past year, or with regard to revenue produced for the purpose of repaying the principal of and interest upon bonded indebtedness, temporary notes or no-fund warrants; and

WHEREAS, despite the desire of the following listed Township Boards to adopt a 2007

Budget while adhering to a maximum level of property taxation described in the foregoing paragraph, the residents of the following listed Townships are to be aware that the 2007 following listed Township Budgets will require property taxes to be levied in an amount greater than the level defined in the desired maximum level defined in the preceding paragraph, due to road improvements.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the following listed Township Boards of Decatur County that it is our desire to notify the public of the increased property taxes to finance the 2007 following listed Township Budgets as defined above and in the 1999 Senate Bill 45.

ADOPTED the Budget Preparation dates of August, 2006 by the various Board Members of the Townships of Altory, Beaver, Custer, Liberty, Lincoln and Pleasant Valley in Decatur County.

Resolution signed at the direction of the State of Kansas and then published as a notice of consideration to the public.

NOTICE AS THE ABOVE RESOLUTION STATES, the same rules and regulations apply for the Lund Cemetery #12 to increase its Budgeted Dollars for special improvements for the 2007 Budget, above and beyond the levied allowance for the 2006 Lund Cemetery Budget.

Adopted by the Board for a \$500 increase and hereby published for notice to the public.

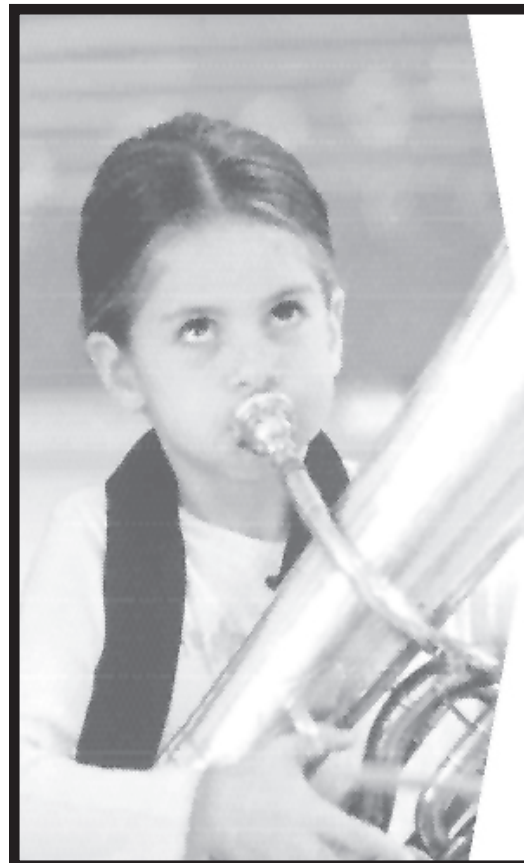

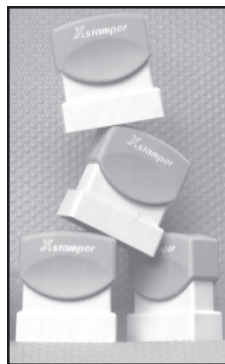
