# Volleyball team stays perfect with 7-0 record

## Lady Devils down Sainty, Colby

The Decatur Community High volleyball varsity ran its perfect match record to 7-0 Tuesday, defeating the St. Francis Indians and the Colby Eagles in a triangular meet in Colby.

The Lady Red Devils defeated St. Francis 25-14 and 25-19 in two straight.

The fired-up Oberlin team applied the heat to the Eagles, downing them in two tough games, 27-25 and 25-21, coming from behind to win the first set.

The wins left the Oberlin varsity game record at 14-1.

In the St. Francis games, team leaders included:

- Top server: Heather Williams, 10 of 10 with one ace.
- Top passer: Tricia Dorshorst, four digs with four three-point service receptions.
- Top setter: Williams, 12 assists.
- Top hitter: Dorshorst, 13 of 16 with five kills.
- Top blocker: Emmie Pauls, two blocks.

"Early in both games, the score was tight," said Coach Patricia

Dorshorst. "We stayed aggressive and pulled away mid-game. We made some defensive adjustments, which the team did well."

In the Colby games:

- Top servers: Pauls, 11 of 12; Lacey Ream, 10 of 10.
  - Top passer: Lauren Fortin, six three-point serve receptions.
  - Top setter: Williams, 15 assists.
  - Top hitters: Sarah Murray, 17 of 13 with six kills; Dorshorst 17 of 19 with five kills.
  - Top blocker: Dorshorst.
- "Colby jumped to a 5-0 lead in the first set of the match," said Coach Dorshorst. "We fought back, evening the score up at 8-8. The Eagles jumped ahead again; this pattern continued until Colby was up 24-21."

The scrappy Oberlin girls refused to lose, diving after every ball. They rallied to tie the score at 24, making key blocks during the comeback. Oberlin went on to win 27-25.

Colby also played Oberlin close in set two.

The Lady Devils jumped out to a quick lead, holding off several Eagle

rallies with outstanding volleys and intense net play.

"It was a well-played match by both teams," Coach Dorshorst said.

In junior varsity action, the Lady Devils split their matches, defeating St. Francis 25-9 and 27-25.

The junior varsity was not so lucky against Colby, losing both games 15-25.

The junior varsity now is 5-2 in match play with a game record of 10-8.

In "C" team action, the young Lady Devils defeated Sharon Springs 25-13 and 25-20. The "C" team match record is now 7-0 with a game record of 12-2.

The freshmen battled St. Francis and won 25-9, 18-25, 15-6. The freshmen then lost to Colby, 13-25 and 12-25.

Their match record is 1-1 and game record 2-3.

The junior varsity was to play in the Quinter Junior Varsity Invitational on Saturday.

The Oberlin varsity was set to play Oakley and Hill City in Hill City on Tuesday.

Oberlin finished in the top four. There were no consolation games.

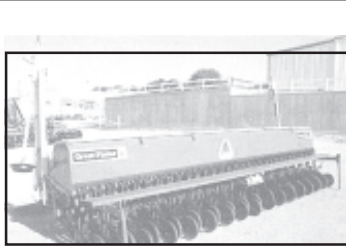
