PUBLIC HEARING NOTICE

The Decatur County Commission will hold a public hearing on Tuesday, October 10, 2006, at 10:00 a.m. in the County Commissioner's Room, Decatur County Courthouse, 120 E Hall, Oberlin, Kansas, for the purpose of considering an application to be submitted to the Kansas Department of Commerce for Small Cities Community Development Block Grant funds under the Community Facilities category. A specific project application to be discussed is the replacement of two standard bridges crossing Sappa Creek located 2 miles south, and 1.3 and 1.4 miles west of Oberlin, Kansas, to serve an area generally southwest of the City of Oberlin. A specific target area map can be seen at the Decatur County Clerk's office. Work will consist of the removal of the existing bridges, the construction of two new 3-18'x8'x56' RFB bridges with roadway widths of 26', clearing, grubbing, excavating, compacting and seeding. The estimated total project cost is \$674,700 with the grant request for \$58,000 of the project cost. Other project proposals introduced at the hearing will be considered. Oral and written comments will be recorded and become a part of the County's CDBG Citizen Participation Plan. Reasonable accommodations will be made available to persons with disabilities. Requests should be submitted to the County Clerk's Office by October 6, 2006.
