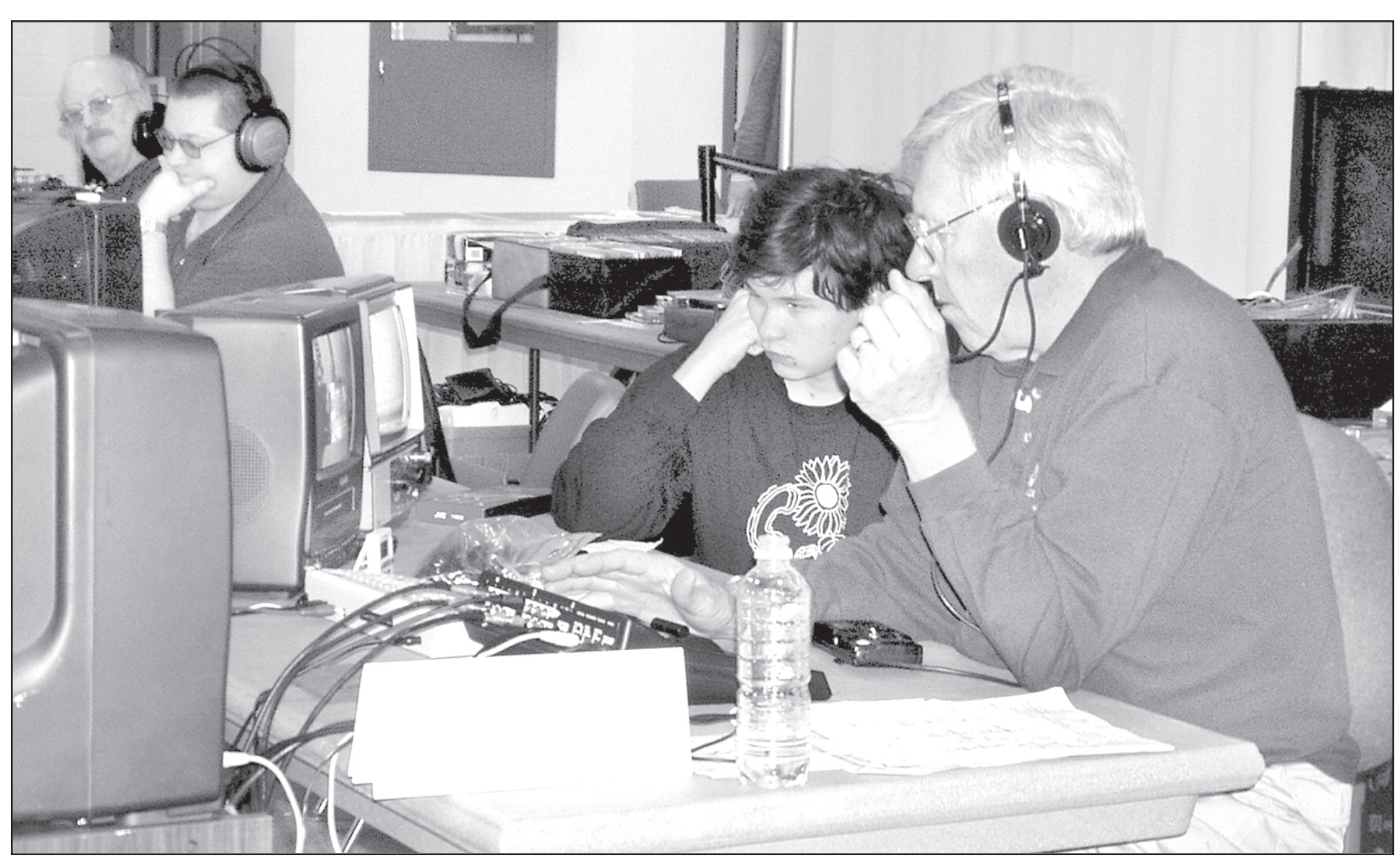




The 'Seeds of Hope' Telethon needs YOUR Help Saturday, February 3
