

Smaller towns offer country living

Decatur County offers smaller communities both incorporated and unincorporated towns full of history for people to make their homes in

Dresden, at the intersection of K-383 and K-123 is in the south-central part of the county. The old city hall building is over 100 years old. The town also has Centennial Park.

The gravel streets and well water are part of country living. Just south of the town are the service station and grain elevator.

Medical facilities are about 30 minutes north and south of town.


From miles away the brick church's double spires can be seen from **Leoville**. Just off of highway 223 the farming community offers necessary utilities such as sewer, electricity and telephone. Emergency services in Leoville are reported through the County 911 system and hospitals, schools and medical services are around 30 minutes away.

In the Beaver Creek valley in the northwest corner of the county sits **Traer**. The area which is a farming community also has many pheasant and wild turkey for hunters in the fall.

A rural electric company serves the community's power needs and 911 emergency services are available. Schools, a hospital and other medical services are only 15 minutes away.

Just off of U.S. 83 people can find **Cedar Bluffs**. The town received the name because of the cedar trees and bluffs on the eastern edge.

Farmland and hunting ground can be found in the community. Emergency services are 10 miles away as well as schools.
