WHEREAS, the City of Jennings must continue to provide services to protect the health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of this community; and WHEREAS, the cost of providing essential services to the citizens of this city continues to increase;

NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Governing Body of the City of Jennings: Section One. In accordance with state law, the City of Jennings has scheduled a public hearing and has prepared the proposed budget necessary to fund city services for January 1, 2008 until December 31, 2008. Section Two. After careful public deliberations, the governing body has determined that in order to maintain the public services that are essential for the citizens of this city, it will be necessary to budget property tax revenues in an amount exceeding the levy in the 2007 Budget. Section Three. This ordinance shall take effect after publication once in the official city newspaper. Passed and approved by the governing Body on this 12th day of July, 2007.

Impounded animals

PUBLIC NOTICE

RESOLUTION NO. 2007-32

A resolution prohibiting the breaking into of a pound and removing an animal therefrom.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF DECATUR COUNTY, KANSAS:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any unauthorized person to open, unlock, break open or attempt to break open any pound which has been established by any city or county for the impoundment of animals, or to take or let out any animal placed therein, or take or attempt to take from an authorized police officer or animal control officer, any animal taken up by him or her under the provisions of any city ordinance or state law, or in any manner interfere with or hinder any authorized officer or employee of any city or county in catching, taking up, or impounding any animal. Section 2. It shall be unlawful for any person or persons, other than those duly authorized, to care for, feed, attempt to feed, or interfere in any way with the care of impounded animals. Section 3. This resolution shall be in full force from and after its publication in the official county newspaper. Passed by the Board of Commissioners of Decatur County, Kansas on this 10th day of July, 2007.
