### Charter **Ordinance 15** PUBLIC NOTICE

CHARTER ORDINANCE NO. 15

A CHARTER ORDINANCE EXEMPTING THE CITY OF OBERLIN, KANSAS FROM KSA 15-209 AND PROVIDING SUBSTI-TUTE AND ADDITIONAL PROVISIONS ON THE SAME SUBJECT, RELATING TO THE APPOINTMENT OF THE CITY CLERK AND CITY TREASURER.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF OBERLIN:

Section 1. The City of Oberlin, Kansas, by the power invested in it by Article 12, Section 5. of the Constitution of the State of Kansas hereby elects to make inapplicable to it and exempts itself from K.S.A. 15-209, which applies to said city but not uniformly to all cities, and provides substitute and additional provisions on the same subject as hereinafter provided.

Section 2. The officers elected or appointed under this act shall be qualified electors of said city, except the city may appoint nonresidents as city clerk, city treasurer, city attorney, municipal judge and as law enforcement officers when deemed necessary, including the appointment of nonresidents who also serve as city clerk, city treasurer, city attorney, municipal judge or law enforcement officers of another municipality or public agency: Provided. That nothing herein shall authorize the appointment of nonresidents of this state. The city attorney, shall be a qualified elector of the county in which said city is located or of an adjoining county. The removal from such city of any officer elected or appointed under this act, who is required to be a qualified elector thereof, shall occasion a vacancy in such office. All vacancies in office, except in the offices of mayor and councilman, may be filled until the next regular governing body. Every appointment by the governing body. Every appointment to office, and the date thereof, shall be entered on the iournal of proceedings of the council.

Section 3. This ordinance shall be published once each week for two consecutive weeks in the official city newspaper

Section 4. This is a charter ordinance and shall take effect sixty-one (61) days after final publication unless a sufficient petition for a referendum is filed and a referendum held on the ordinance as provided in Article 12, Section 5, Subdivision (c)(3) of the Constitution of Kansas, in which case the ordinance shall become effective if approved by a majority of the electors voting thereon.

ORDINANCE NO. 817

AN ORDINANCE BANNING SMOKING IN BUILDINGS AND VEHICLES BELONG-ING TO OR OCCUPIED BY THE CITY OF OBERLIN

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF OBERLIN, KAN-SAS, that:

Section 1. Pursuant to powers granted by the Legislature to cities, smoking is hereby prohibited in all city-owned or occupied build-ings. Smoking is also prohibited in any city owned motor vehicles, including all emergency vehicles and vehicles with permanent license plates.

Section 2. The penalty for violations of this ordinance are as set forth in K.S.A. 21-4012.

Section 3. Appropriate signage in each building and vehicle covered by this ordinance shall be placed by the respective department head or person in charge of each particular building or vehicle

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect from and after its publication in the official city newspaper




