(Continued from Page 1A) pened if the people had had their seat belts on and stayed in the vehicle," the trooper said. "Luckily, the one wasn't ejected so he could go for help."

The man had to walk to the nearest farmhouse, about a quarter mile to the east, to call 911, he said.

Within minutes, fire fighters and medical technicians were pouring in to help.

Trooper Boydston said as far as he could tell, the driver, who wasn't old enough to have a full license, did not have either a restricted driver's license or a learner's permit. No tickets have been issued so far, he said.
