Racing dignitaries watching the races and helping out included former NASCAR Cup driver Randy LaJoie, who gave safety tips to the drivers, and race chaser and author Allen Brown of Michigan.


At the end of the night, Murray and Dalton Dolan of Oberlin, Travis Sherfick of WaKeeney, Kelly Karnopp of Norton and Max Pollmann of Trenton, Neb., were the winners of the A features.

Murray had won the previous two A features this year in Oberlin and had won each of the three previous nights of the tour. He won his 400th career IMCA modified win on Friday at Jetmore and then again on Saturday in Dodge City and on Sunday in Colby.




