## Buff's beat Devils Oberlin falls to Atwood

The visitors were just too tough for the home team Friday, and Oberlin lost its homecoming game 44-12 to the Rawlins County Buffaloes.

Atwood drew first blood with a two-yard scoring run in the first quarter, then had a successful two-point conversion to lead the Decatur Community High boys 8-0 at the end of one.

In the second quarter, Rawlins County scored twice, but each time was unable to make the point-after, so at the half, the visitors were ahead 20-0.

Both teams scored in the third quarter, with the Rawlins County going first on a seven-yard run. The conversion after was good and the Buffaloes led 28-0.

Oberlin answered with a one-yard scoring run by senior Lucas Fortin. The point after was no good, and at the end of three, Atwood was up 28-6.

Oberlin was able to get across the goal line first in the fourth quarter,



as Fortin sent a 45-yard pass to junior Toby Peters for a touchdown. Although the point after was no good, the score was a more respectable 28-12.

Then the Buffaloes put up two more touchdowns with extra points in the fourth quarter to win the game 44-12.

Fortin completed nine of 26 passing attempts for 160 yards and a touchdown.

His receivers were Peters, who took four for 116 yards and a touchdown; senior Lucas Juenemann, two for 19; senior Sam Stapp, one for 29; and senior Jacob Fortin, two for minus four.

Leading rushers for Oberlin were J. Fortin, nine carries for 64 yards; Juenemann, one for 11; L. Fortin, 12 for 10 with a touchdown; and Stapp, four for a minus 30.

Oberlin's record is now 1-3.

The Red Devils will face the Trego Community High Golden Eagles at 7 p.m. Friday in WaKeeney.
