Eighth graders beat Buffaloes; seventh, loses

The Oberlin eighth-grade basketball boys beat the Rawlins County Buffaloes 42-29 at home on Monday, but when the visitors locked horns with the Decatur Community Junior High seventh-grade Red Devils, Oberlin lost 35-31.

"When we are patient on offense, we play well as a team," Coach Tim Breth said of his eighth graders. "I would like to see more balance in our scoring. With this win we probably have locked up a first-round home game for the Northwest Kansas League tournament in late December."

The eighth-grade team is now 6-2, he said.

Helping with the victory were Zach May, 22 points and four rebounds; Channing Fortin, 8 points and seven rebounds; Tyler Brugge-man, 4 points and seven rebounds; Kade Brown, 4 points and three steals; Matt Glading, 2 points and six rebounds; and Ryan May, 2 points and three steals.

The seventh-graders came close but couldn't quite overcome the Buffaloes.

"We took a lot of ill-advised shots," Coach Breth said. "When a team does that, shooting percentage usually suffers."

"The first half really hurt us, but through it all, the team continued to play very hard."

The seventh graders are now 4-2.

Scoring for Oberlin were Kolton Paul, 9 points, eight rebounds and two steals; Kennedy Fortin, 7 points, 12 rebounds and three blocks; Grant Gilliam, 7 points, seven rebounds and three blocks; Kyle Breth, 6 points; and Konner Fortin, 2 points and eight rebounds.

Coach Joe Dreher said that practices have been going well, but he is short in the top and bottom weights. If a team can't field a wrestler in any class, it has to forfeit, which gives the other team the same points as a pin.

Oberlin is not the only school suffering from lack of numbers, Dreher said. Oakley, the Red Devils' first opponent, has only about 12 wrestlers, he said.

pounds; Everett Urban, 145, a state qualifier last year; and Nathan Simonsson, 171; juniors Gatlin Reichert, 125/130; Daniel Jordan, 152; and Jaxen Alstrom, 189/215; and sophomores Jacob Helm, 112, a state qualifier; Nolan Peters, 125; Jacob Larue, 189/215; and Dalton Pauls, 140.

Rounding out the team are juniors Cody Kane, 130, and Ray Zodrow, 140/145; sophomore Jon Samson, 130/135; and freshman Brent Juenemann, 119.

The first match will be at 6:30 Friday in Oakley. On Saturday, the Red Devils will be at the Hoxie Tournament starting at 9 a.m.


