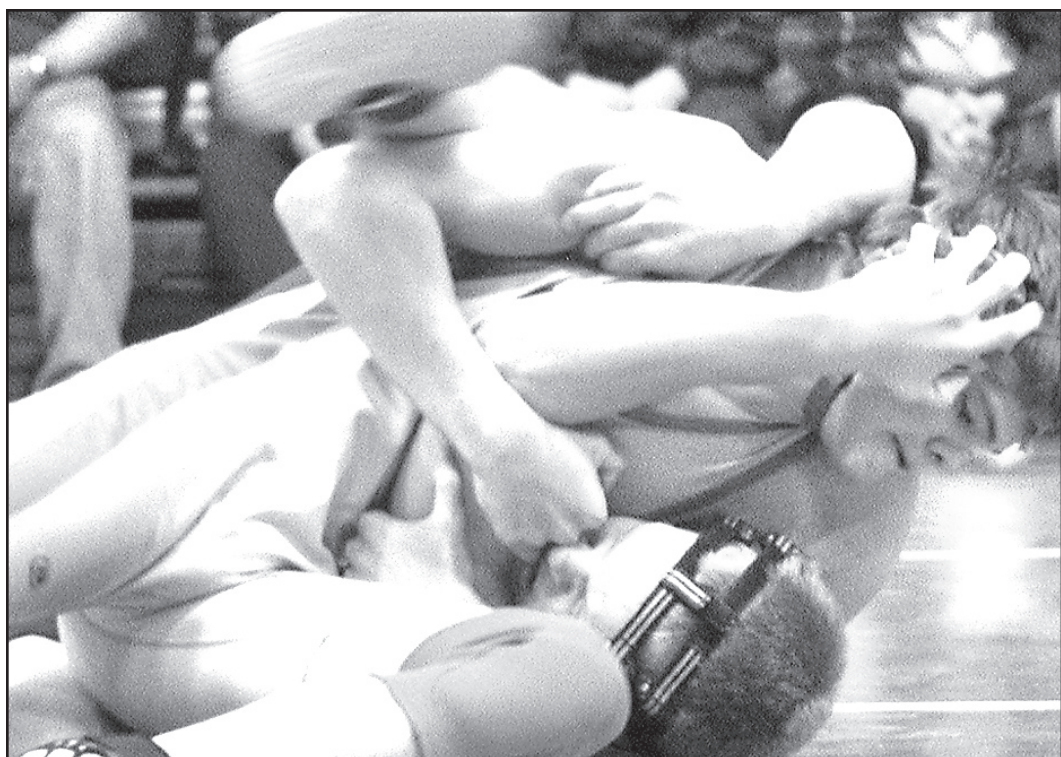
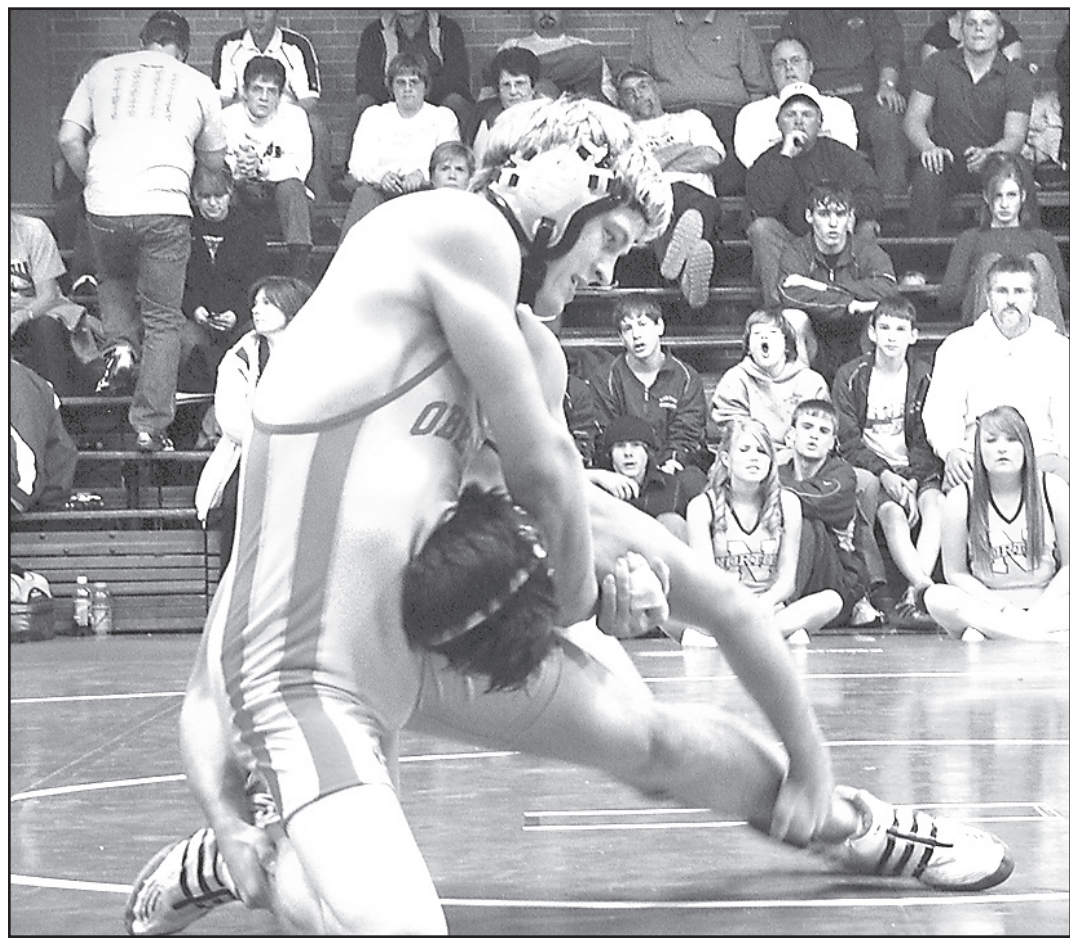

Boys take second in tourney

While Norton High won the Hoxie Invitational Wrestling Tournament on Saturday, Decatur Community High came in second and had three first-place finishers.

The Red Devils finished first at 152, 160 and 171 pounds, second at 135 and 215, third at 189 and fourth at 112 and 118.

Everett Urban, Daniel Jordan and Nathan Simonsson defeated all opposition to help Oberlin take second in a nine-school field.

Norton had 210.5 points, followed by Oberlin with 140; Plainville, 105; Lakin, 78; Hoxie, 77; Oakley, 70; Holcomb, 57; Cimarron, 39; and WaKeeney, 28.
