Phillipsburg, McCook come to town for wrestling

The Oberlin wrestling team played host to Phillipsburg and McCook last Tuesday but ended up on the wrong end of the scoring with both.

Phillipsburg edged the Red Devils 36-34 after Oberlin had to forfeit two weight classes and the Panthers only one.

Oberlin had no one in the 103- and 285-pound classes so forfeited 12 points while Phillipsburg was shy at 119 pounds and forfeited 6.

The Decatur Community High Lady Red Devils got a Northwest Kansas League win in basketball on Friday as they defeated the Rawlins County Lady Buffaloes 67-56 in Oberlin.

“This was a really good and much-needed league win for us,” Coach Terry Ream said. “I believe the girls have learned a lot this last week, and I was really pleased with how they stepped up and played as a team. We know we still have a long way to go, but we are on the right track and will strive to keep our effort in the future at a high level.”

In the first quarter, Oberlin was way out in front of Atwood, outscoring the Lady Buffaloes 20-8.

The Rawlins County girls came back in the second period to outgun Oberlin 18-12 but the Oberlin still lead 32-26 at the half.

Oberlin held on for the win, outscoring Atwood 17-13 in the third quarter and 18-17 in the fourth.
