

Lady Red Devils outplay Bulldogs

The Oberlin Lady Red Devils basketball team downed the Golden Plains Lady Bulldogs 58-35 in Rexford last Tuesday.

At the end of the first quarter, the Golden Plains girls were ahead of the Decatur Community High team by a narrow 11-10. The Lady Red Devils didn't let up and came out strong in the second quarter, outscoring Golden Plains 21-6 for a tidy 31-17 lead at the half. In the third quarter, Oberlin outscored Golden Plains 19-9 to lead 50-27.

Coach Terry Ream gave his bench some playing time and in the fourth quarter, and the Lady Bulldogs were able to out hit Oberlin 9-8.

"I was pleased with the effort we had, especially on defense," Coach Ream said. "We had a night where everything just clicked. We took care of the ball, attacked the basket on offense and played one of our best overall defensive games of the year."

Bulldog boys down Oberlin

The Decatur Community High boys basketball team fell 69-59 to the Golden Plains Bulldogs last Tuesday in Rexford.

The Bulldogs pulled ahead in the first half and Oberlin was not able to catch up in the second.

After the first quarter, the Red Devils were down by five with Golden Plains leading 19-14. In the second quarter, the Bulldogs kept the lead, outscoring the Red Devils 24-13 to lead 43-27 at the half. The Red Devils came out of the locker room and outscored the home team 17-11 in the third quarter. But, although Oberlin was able to keep up with the Bulldogs in the final quarter, they were not able to pull ahead and each team scored 15.

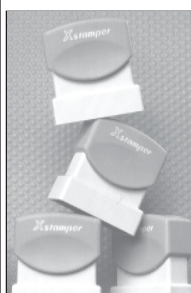
