

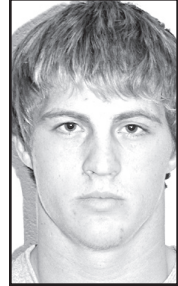

Oberlin sends one wrestler to state tourney

Oberlin will be sending one wrestler to the state tournament in Hays this weekend.

Senior Everett Urban took second place in the 152-pound class to win a berth at state. Decatur Community High came in 10th out of 20 teams at the Class 3-2-1A regional tournament in Ellis over the weekend.

Norton won the regional meet with 192.5 points, followed by Goodland, 135; Hoisington, 107.5; St. Francis, 102;

Oakley, 83.5; Ellis, 75; Hoxie, 67; Lakin, 60; Cimarron, 59; Oberlin, 56; Atwood, 55; Thomas Moore Prep of Hays, 53.5; Holcomb, 43.5; Leoti, 28; WaKeeney, 27; Hill City, 23; Elkhart, 13; Montezuma, 10; Larned, 4; and Sublette and Rolla, 0 each.

Because only the top four finishers in each weight go on to state, said Oberlin Coach Joe Dreher, there were no matches to determine fifth and sixth

place. If there had been, Oberlin's Jacob Larue and Nathan Simonsson would have been in them.

The state tournament will be Friday and Saturday at Busch-Gross Coliseum on the Fort Hays State University campus. To get there, take the west Hays exit (U.S. 183 Bypass) and go south across the creek and railroad bridges, then turn left.

Young Red Devils take fourth place in Phillipsburg

The Decatur Community Junior High wrestlers placed fourth out of 14 teams at a tournament in Phillipsburg on Feb. 14.

The team came home with two champions, Dayton Dreher and Channing Fortin; a second-place finisher, Cody Wurm; third place, Zach May; and three fourths, Kyle Breth, Kolton Paul and Konner Fortin.

Russell won the tournament with 168 points, followed by Plainville, 164; Felten (Hays), 145; Oberlin, 125; Phillipsburg, 113; WaKeeney, 105.5; Ellis, 89; Phillipsburg junior varsity, 57.5; Felten junior varsity, 52; Stockton, 34; Plainville junior varsity, 23; Ellis junior varsity, 15; Oberlin junior varsity, 8; and Russell junior varsity, 4.

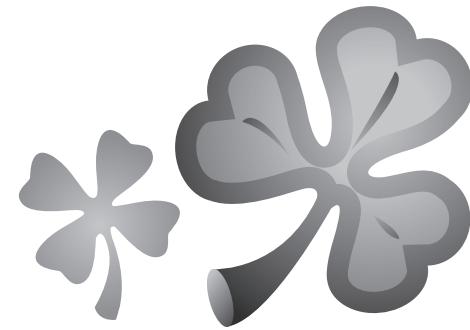
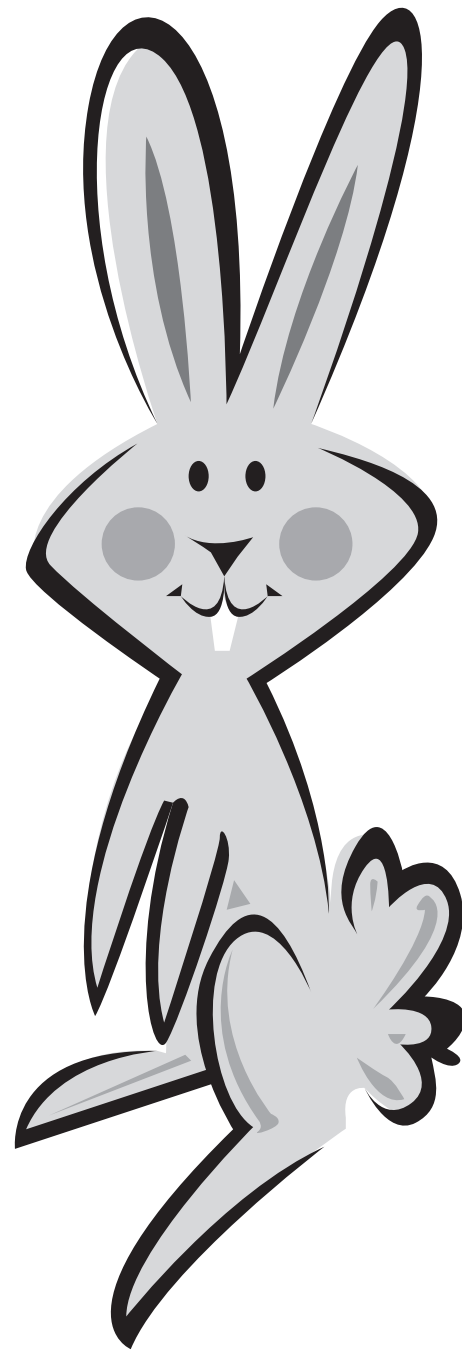
• 265 pounds — Ben Glading was pinned in the first period by Brady Chard, Plainville, and by John Arnold, Plainville junior varsity.
