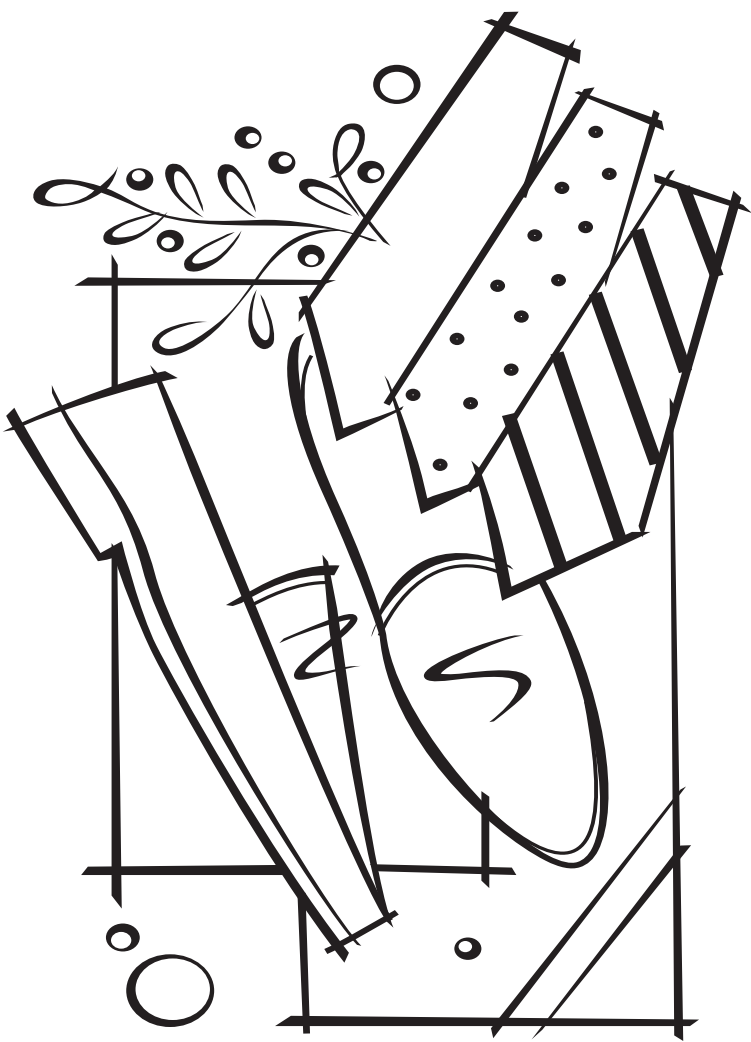


Dads

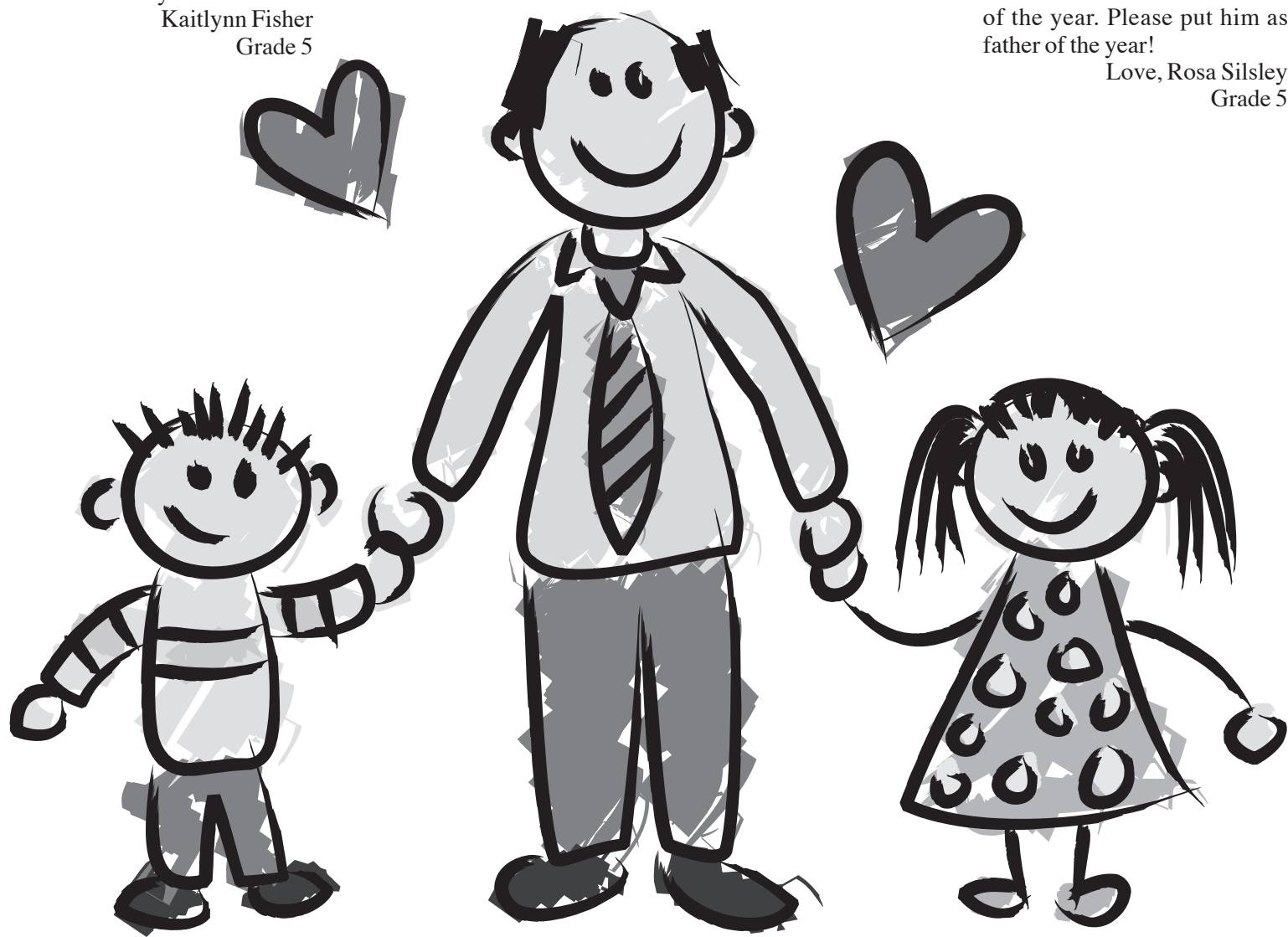
