The first two ordinances passed 125 years ago included No.1 being the vacation of Oberlin public square and No. 2 granting the right of way to the Burlington, Kansas and Southwestern Company, through certain streets of the city.

Minutes from the first meeting included talk about the need for a city prison. Also on the agenda was a \$65 charge from the Pratt Brothers for removing 13 dead horses. The matter was referred to the city marshal for investigation and later the charge of \$50 was paid to the brothers.


