

CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT QUESTION NO. 2 A PROPOSITION to amend section 2 of article 5 of the Constitution of the State of Kansas, relating to qualification of voters.

Section 1. The following proposition to amend the Constitution of the State of Kansas shall be submitted to the qualified electors of the state for their approval or rejection: Section 2 of article 5 of the constitution of the state of Kansas is hereby amended to read

**"§ 2. Disqualification to vote.** The legislature may, by law, exclude persons from voting because of mental illness or commitment to a jail or penal institution. No person convicted of a felony under the laws of any state or of the United States, unless pardoned or restored to his civil rights, shall be qualified to vote.

"Explanatory statement. This amendment would repeal the authority of the legislature to

exclude persons with mental illness from voting.
"A vote for this amendment would ensure that the right to vote for persons with mental

illness cannot be taken away by the legislature. A vote against this amendment would continue the current authority of the legislature to take away the right to vote for persons with mental illness."
