Eighth graders place second in Cheylin Scholar Bowl

The 8th Grade Scholar Bowl team placed second at the Cheylin Junior High Scholar Bowl Tournament on Oct. 18.

The 8th graders finished the day with 6 wins and 3 losses.

The Oberlin 8th grade team includes Kaine Fredrickson, Regent Erickson, Caitlin Shields, Kaleb Teddlie, Ganon Henningson and Garrett Scott.

Tri-Plains beat Oberlin 60-40 in

the first round, but Oberlin came back in the second round and defeated Goodland 90-30.

In round 3, Oberlin defeated Weskan 60-30 and Brewster 60-40 in round 4. In round 5, Oberlin beat Rawlins County 80-65.

Cheylin beat Oberlin 60-25 in round 6, but Oberlin came back in the next round, defeating Greeley County 70-10.

Oberlin won round 8 over Wal-

lace County, 70-30, but then lost the final round 55-35 to Golden Plains.

Rawlins County won the tournament. Oberlin, Cheylin, and Greeley County all tied for second place, but Oberlin won the three-way tie breaker based on the margin of victory.

Rawlins County placed second overall, followed by Golden Plains and Cheylin.

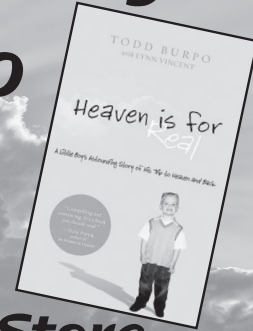
