RESTRICTIONS BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING

Section One. Oberlin City Code section 3-206 is modified as follows:

RESTRICTION UPON LOCATION. (a) No license shall be issued for the sale at retail of any cereal malt beverage on premises which are located in areas not zoned for such

(b) It shall be unlawful to sell or dispense at retail any cereal malt beverage at any place within the city limits that is within a 200-foot

radius of any church, school or library. (c) The provisions of this section shall not apply to any establishment holding a private club license issued by the State of Kansas.

Section Two. All ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section Three. This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its publication in the official city newspaper
