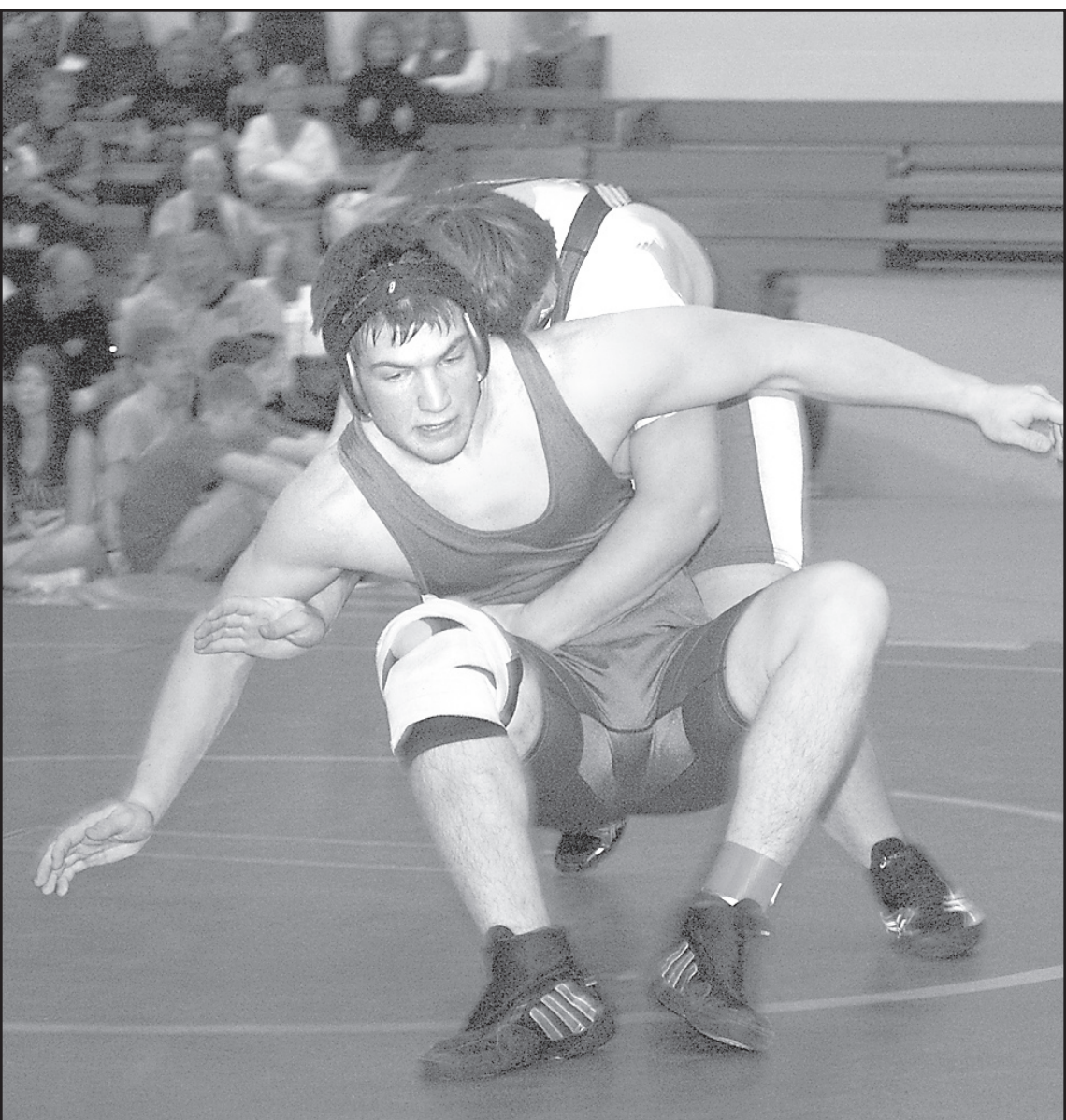

Wrestlers take fifth in Oberlin Invitational

The Decatur Community High boys came in fifth out of nine teams at the annual Oberlin Invitational Wrestling Tournament on Saturday.

While the Red Devils had no champions, three wrestlers came in second, one took third and three took fourth place.

Kearney won the tournament with 230.5 points and six champions, followed by Goodland, 147.5; McCook, 105.5; Smith Center, 103; Oberlin, 99; Wray, Colo., 83; Oakley, 42; Hill City, 25; and Osborne, 0.

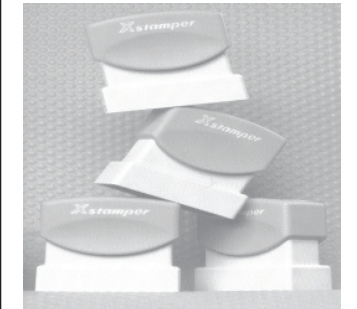
Wrestling for Oberlin were:
