Oberlin girls take second

The Decatur Community High girls track team came in second at the Rawlins County Invitational in Atwood last Tuesday.

The Dundy County, Neb., girls scored 142 points to lead the pack, followed by Oberlin with 139; Hitchcock County, Neb., 118; Goodland, 45; Colby, 44; and Rawlins County, 38.

The fleet-footed Oberlin relay teams outran all others to bring home three firsts.

Senior Jordan Dreher brought home two golds, winning both the shot put and the javelin. In the javelin, her throw was almost 37 feet farther than the next contestant.

Freshman Kayla Jones took the gold for Oberlin in the high jump.


