The soldiers in the 714th, said Capt. Coco, saw a lot of action and several members, including him, were wounded and honored with a Purple Heart medal. While serving overseas, he said,

he was amazed by the outreach from people in the United States. They received packages with everything a soldier could want.

to Kansas. Of the 46 who deployed with the 714th, he said, the unit had two killed in action and 17 who brought home Purple Hearts.
