

Fair open to all ages

Pictures, vegetables, arts, crafts, flowers and more will all be entered under the open class division of the upcoming Decatur County Fair.

People don't have to be members of one of the 4-H groups to enter something into the fair. They don't even have to be kids. It's open to all ages.

The fair book states that it's open to the general public regardless of age or residence.

Probably the largest three areas in which people enter items for the open class are quilting, arts and crafts and photography.

Those who place do get a premium award for their items. The premiums, or money won, is based on a point system and how many dollars are in the pot to give away. While it's been around \$1 a point, that doesn't mean that's how it will continue.

While the largest percentage of the open class entries are women, there are always a few men who enter too.

In the open class people can enter in clothing, crafts, day camp exhibits, eggs, fine art, floriculture, food preparation, food preservation, horse, horticulture, livestock, needlework, photography, quilting, scouts, stained glass, woodworking and non-commercial booth exhibits.

Anyone wanting to enter can bring their items to the open class building between 9 a.m. and noon on Tuesday, Aug. 2. The superintendent will be there to help people. The judging will take place at 1 p.m.
