AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING WATER RATES BE IT ORDAINED by the Governing Body

of the City of Oberlin, Kánsas, Section 1. That Section 17-201 of the City

Code of the City of Oberlin, Kansas, is hereby amended

17-201. WATER RATES. Residents of the city shall pay for their use and consumption of water furnished or supplied by the city at the feet or any part thereof; from 751 cubic feet to thousand cubic feet, and any from 2,001 cubic feet and above, the rate will be \$18.40 per thousand cubic feet. Water provided outside the city limits of Oberlin shall be charged at a rate of \$15.30 for the first 750 cubic feet or any part thereof; from 751 cubic feet to 2,000 ubic fee, the rate will be \$21.10 per thousand cubic feet, and any from 2.001 cubic feet and above, the rate will be \$23,00 per cubic feet Additionally, the following charges for water furnished or supplied by the city and obtained through each meter, or obtained for each separate property

(a) Through 5/8ths inch to 3/4 inch water

(b) Through 1 inch water meters 17.00
